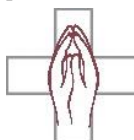

Holy Communion is celebrated today.

The Sacrament of the Altar is the true body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ under the bread and wine, for us Christians to eat and to drink, instituted by Christ Himself. Jesus Christ is present in the sacrament by His Word and we receive His gifts through faith for the assurance of the forgiveness of our sins and for strength to live new life in Him.

Our practice of closed communion is the historic practice of the church. It is prompted by love, both for God's Word and God's people. It does not deny that members of other denominations are Christians. Rather, it acknowledges God's deep concern for doctrinal truth (Rom. 16:17) and the Bible's witness that doctrinal unity is central to the common reception of this sacrament.

For this reason, guests who desire to commune are asked to speak with the pastor before the service.

Advance registration for this service today is also registration for communion. In the interim the use of communion registration cards will be suspended and have been removed from the pews.

Those who are not yet confirmed are welcome to come to receive a blessing, but are asked to keep their hands folded.

A READING FROM THE BOOK OF CONCORD

FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER THE EPIPHANY

LARGE CATECHISM, TEN COMMANDMENTS

First Commandment: *"You shall have no other gods."*

You shall have me alone as your God. What does it mean to have a god? Or, what is God?

Answer: A god means that from which we are to expect all good and in which we are to take refuge in all distress. So, to have a God is nothing other than trusting and believing Him with the heart...

A person's entire heart and all his confidence must be placed in God alone and in no one else. For to "have" God is not to take hold of Him with our hands or to put Him in a bag like money. Instead, to "have" Him means that the heart takes hold of Him and clings to Him, to trust in Him entirely. For this reason God wishes to turn us away from everything else that exists outside of Him and to draw us to Himself (John 6:44). For He is the only eternal good (Matthew 19:17). It is as though He would say, "Whatever you have previously sought from the saints, or for whatever things you have trusted in money or anything else, expect it all from Me. Think of Me as the one who will help you and pour out upon you richly all good things."

This is the meaning of true honor and worship of God, which pleases God, and which He commands under penalty of eternal wrath. The heart knows no other comfort or confidence than in Him and must not allow itself to be torn from Him, but risk and disregard everything. (pars. 1,2,13-16)
