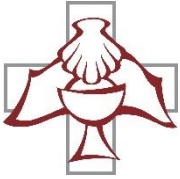

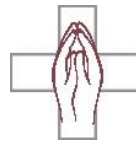

Holy Communion is celebrated today.

The Sacrament of the Altar is the true body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ under the bread and wine, for us Christians to eat and to drink, instituted by Christ Himself. Jesus Christ is present in the sacrament by His Word and we receive His gifts through faith for the assurance of the forgiveness of our sins and for strength to live new life in Him.

Advance registration for this service today is also registration for communion. In the interim the use of communion registration cards will be suspended and have been removed from the pews. Also the use of the common cup will be suspended for the time being.

Those who are not yet confirmed are welcome to come to receive a blessing, but are asked to keep their hands folded.

Bible Study may resume in person in the next few weeks. Alternatives are via electronic means. If you are interested, please talk to Pastor Wood.

“I was glad when they said to me, ‘Let us go to the house of the LORD!’” (Psalm 122:1 ESV) **We give thanks to God that in-person Divine Service** has resumed with some modifications. On June 21 in Manitoba we may be allowed to have up to 30% capacity at St. Matthew's up to a maximum of 50 people. We will have one more week of two services at St. Matthew's with the hope that on June 28 we will have one service at St. Matthew's (at 9:30 MB) and a service (for the first time in 15 weeks) at Grace (10:30 SK). SDG (Soli Deo Gloria, not Social Distancing Guidelines). When both congregations are open we will have our Easter Celebration service on a “little Easter” Sunday.

A big thank you needs to be extended to Concordia Publishing House for the use of Lutheran Service Builder and the free license (which ends June 30). Lutheran Service Builder has allowed us to legally livestream the service with the hymns and to post the order of service on our parish website. The cost is \$425 USD for the first year and \$175 after the first year, plus \$75 USD/year for the hymn license for the parish. It is hoped that we may be able to continue to use this for our livestreaming ministry (this was not budgeted but special offerings for this would be welcomed). A READING FROM THE BOOK OF CONCORD

SECOND SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST FORMULA OF CONCORD, SOLID DECLARATION ARTICLE X, CHURCH PRACTICES

As soon as Christian freedom is weakened and human traditions are forced on the Church with coercion, as though it were wrong and a sin to omit them, the way is already prepared for idolatry. In this way, human traditions are multiplied and regarded as a divine worship, not only equal to God's ordinances, but even placed above them.

Furthermore, idolaters are confirmed in their idolatry by such yielding and conforming in outward things. True believers are grieved, offended, and weakened in their faith. Every Christian, for the sake of his soul's welfare and salvation, is bound to avoid these, as it is written:

Woe to the world for temptations to sin! (Matthew 18:7)

But whoever causes one of these little ones who believe in Me to sin, it would be better for him to have a great millstone fastened around his neck and to be drowned in the depth of the sea. (Matthew 18:6)

But what Christ says is to be especially remembered:

So everyone who acknowledges Me before men, I also will acknowledge before My Father who is in heaven. (Matthew 10:32)

This has always been the faith and confession about such matters, by the chief teachers of the Augsburg Confession. We follow in their footsteps and we intend to persevere in their confession by God's grace. (paragraphs 15-18)

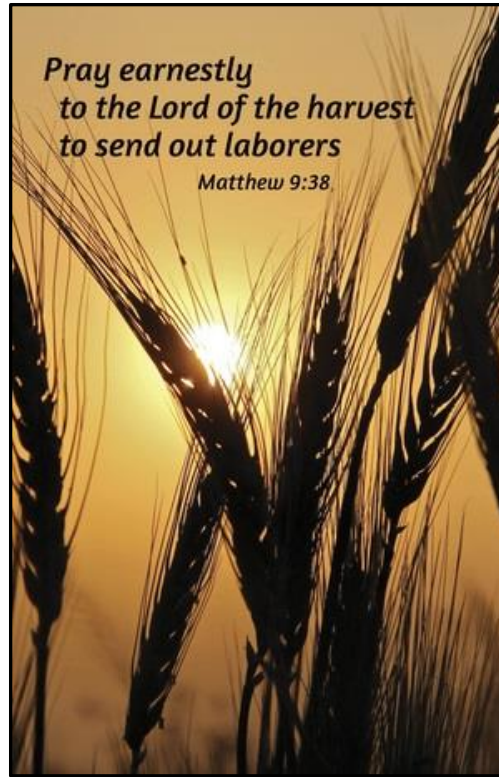
