The Sacrament of the Altar is the true body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ under the bread and wine, for us Christians to eat and to drink, instituted by Christ Himself. Jesus Christ is

present in the sacrament by His Word and we receive His gifts through faith for the assurance of the forgiveness of our sins and for strength to live new life in Him.

Our practice of closed communion is the historic practice of the church. It is prompted by love, both for God's Word and God's people. It does not deny that members of other denominations are Christians. Rather, it acknowledges God's deep concern for doctrinal truth (Rom. 16:17) and the Bible's witness that doctrinal unity is central to the common reception of this sacrament.

For this reason, guests who desire to commune are asked to speak with the pastor before the service.

Please mark the registration sheet for communion and worship attendance in the narthex. In the interim the use of communion registration cards will be suspended and have been removed from the pews.

Those who are not yet confirmed are welcome to come to receive a blessing, but are asked to keep their hands folded.

A reminder that **Pews 13, 14, 15, 16** (at the back at St. Matthew's) are reserved for those who desire to physically distance.

A READING FROM THE BOOK OF CONCORD

THIRD SUNDAY OF EASTER LARGE CATECHISM, PART II, APOSTLES' CREED

Here we learn to know the Second Person of the Godhead... and how we have been redeemed.

If you are asked, "What do you believe in the Second Article about Jesus Christ?" answer, "I believe that Jesus Christ, God's true Son, has become my Lord." "But what does it mean to become Lord?" "It is this. He has redeemed me from sin, the devil, death, and all evil. Before I did not have a Lord or King, but was captive under the devil's power, condemned to death, stuck in sin and blindness"...

So those tyrants and jailers are all expelled now. In their place has come Jesus Christ, Lord of life, righteousness, every blessing, and salvation. He has delivered us poor, lost people from hell's jaws, has won us, has made us free, and has brought us again into the Father's favor and grace. He has taken us as His own property under His shelter and protection so that He may govern us by His righteousness, wisdom, power, life, and blessedness.

The word *Lord* means simply the same as *redeemer*. It means the One who has brought us from Satan to God, from death to life, from sin to righteousness, and who preserves us in the same. But all the points in this article serve to explain and express this redemption. They explain how and by whom it was accomplished. They explain how much it cost Him and what He spent and risked so that He might win us and bring us under His dominion. (paragraphs 26-27, 30-31)
