



Amos 5:6–7, 10–15

**P** The Old Testament Reading is from the fifth chapter of Amos.

<sup>6</sup>Seek the LORD and live. lest he break out like fire in the house of Joseph, and it devour, with none to quench it for Bethel, <sup>7</sup>O you who turn justice to wormwood and cast down righteousness to the earth! . . . <sup>10</sup>They hate him who reproves in the gate, and they abhor him who speaks the truth. <sup>11</sup>Therefore because you trample on the poor and you exact taxes of grain from him, you have built houses of hewn stone, but you shall not dwell in them; you have planted pleasant vineyards, but you shall not drink their wine. <sup>12</sup>For I know how many are your transgressions and how great are your sins you who afflict the righteous, who take a bribe,

13Therefore he who is prudent will keep silent in such a time, for it is an evil time.



I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life 




### **Distribution**
